The course on Multilevel Justice aims at exploring limits and strengths of the European multilevel system of "constitutional" recognition and judicial protection of fundamental rights and freedoms which is characterized by different layers of normative recognition and by the concurring jurisdiction of national constitutional courts, the European Court of Human Rights, the Court of Justice of the European Union, and International Criminal Tribunals. By drawing from the experience of the invited international speakers, the course will examine the influences exerted on each other by the different players and by the different sources of law, evaluating the effectiveness of such complex system of protection of fundamental rights.
